

Natl cyber crime training prog concludes

The valediction ceremony of the 4th National Cyber Crime Training Programme was organised at Police Radio Training School (PRTS) on Saturday. JP Mangai, commissioner, custom and excise was the chief guest of the ceremony.

Police officials from 12 states participated in the 10-day training programme along with officials of six central paramilitary forces like BSF, CISF, CRPF, ITBP, SSB and NDF. On the occasion certificates were given to the participants by chief guest.

Describing about the event, inspector general Sarun Kapoor said that



PRTS was the only technical institute that was educating people regularly from past two years. In this continuous education and awareness programme till date around 45 training programme and five semi-

nars have been organised and more than 2500 police officials have been trained, Kapoor said. Besides, the centre has trained several school and college students, members of different organisations under

various training programme organised regularly, he said.

In addition to this, a week-long "Advanced Cyber Security Course" for officials of the Madhya Pradesh STF and ATS from February 17 to 22 was also organised. Participants of this programme were also given certificates by the chief guest.
